- Used to talk about temporary actions that are happening right now.
- **Keywords** (الكلمات الدالة): *right now, now, at the moment.*
- **Example** (مثال): The students **are writing** a test **at the moment**.

3. Present Perfect (المضارع التام)

- يُستخدم للتحدث عن أفعال حدثت في وقت غير محدد في الماضي، أو أفعال بدأت في الماضي ومستمرة حتى الآن.
- Used to talk about actions that happened at an indefinite time in the past, or actions from the past up to now.
- **Keywords** (الكلمات الدالة): *ever, never, so far, yet.*
- **Example** (مثال): The students **haven't written** a test **yet**.

4. Simple Past (الماضي البسيط)

- يُستخدم للتحدث عن أفعال بدأت وانتهت بالكامل في وقت محدد في الماضي.
- Used to talk about actions that were completed at a specific time in the past.
- **Keywords** (الكلمات الدالة): *yesterday, last week, two days ago, a year ago, in the 19th century, in 2010.*
- **Example** (مثال): The students **wrote** a test **last week**.

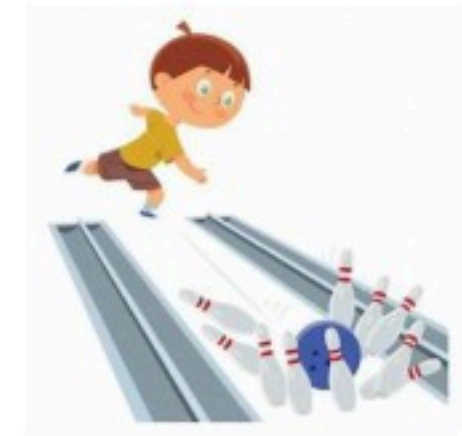

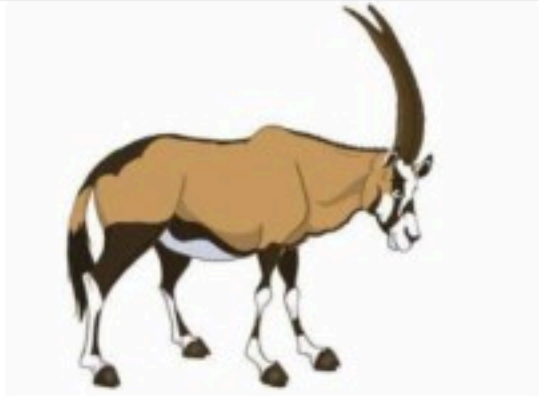

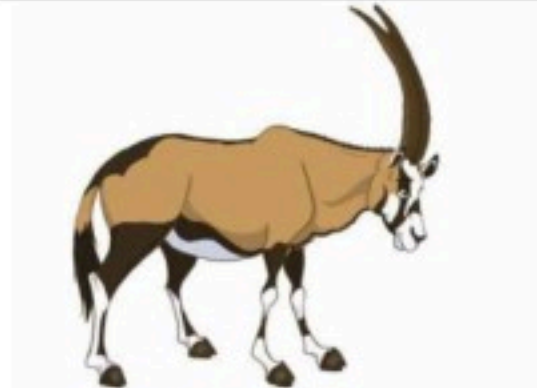
